Western Governors University has committed itself to pay certain self-insured Medical, Prescription Drug, Health Flexible Spending Account, Dental, and Short-term Disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Fidelity Security Life Insurance Company, Cigna Health and Life insurance Company and Affiliates, Spring Health, Reliance Standard Life Insurance Company, Pre-Paid Legal Services dba LegalShield, Life Insurance Company of North America, University Health Alliance, and Lincoln National Life Insurance Company to pay Medical, Prescription Drug, Dental, Vision, Life Insurance, Long-term Disability, Accidental Death and Dismemberment, Employee Assistance Program, Legal, Critical Illness, Accident, Prepaid Dental and Hospital Indemnity claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2023 were \$7,858,756.
